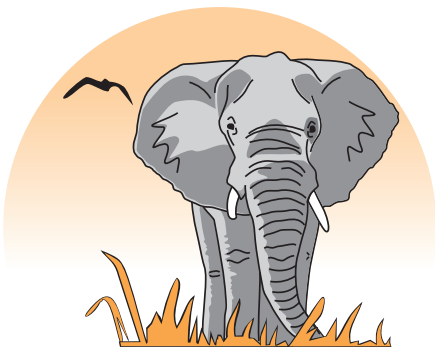

BORNEO Project

Sample Itinerary

Day 01/02 April - 04

Your flight departs Calgary at 10:55PM on Air Canada for Vancouver. There you will be connecting with Cathay Pacific departing at 2:55AM. Due to crossing the International Dateline, your flight actually arrives in Hong Kong the following morning.

Day 03 April 05

Upon arrival in Hong Kong, you will transfer on to your final connection to Kota Kinabalu. Upon arrival you will be met by your local guide who will have you taken to your hotel where you will get orientated and have a briefing of the program ahead. There will be time for a walk around (maybe a chance to hit the internet) before hitting a local restaurant for an early dinner then bed.

Day 04 April 06

After an early breakfast you will get an understanding of the city of Kota Kinabalu by heading of on a heritage walk. The tour begins right at the Padang Merdeka and will cover other historical sites and buildings such as the Atkinson Clock Tower, Australia Place, Community Centre, Sabah Tourism Building, Jesselton Hotel, Gaya Street, Pocket Park, Malaysia Monument, North Borneo War Memorial and the City Council (Hall).

There will be a short stop over at the Museum Kopitiam (coffee shop) for a simple traditional tea break. A bit of fun is added with a short treasure hunt at Gaya Street, the oldest street in Kota Kinabalu, where you will be sent searching for historical facts. This will provide a chance for the students to mingle with the local people and get a further sampling of the culture.

Day 05 April 07

Today you board a morning flight to Sandakan. After the short flight you will be met and transferred to the jetty for the boat ride to Turtle Island Park where you will spend the night. The park is a haven for the endangered green and hawksbill turtles and gives you the rare experience of seeing a turtle landing. This is not the main season for their nesting but the chances are still strong of seeing them. Observe the tagging of the mother turtles, collection of eggs and release of the babies into the sea.

Day 06 April 08

Return back to Sandakan in the morning where you will check into the Sepilok Jungle Resort. Later that afternoon you will meet with the head ranger of the Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre and get a briefing on their program that will educate you on the threats and survival status of orangutans and the center.

NOTE:

Orangutan Rehabilitation was established in 1964 by Mrs. Barbara Harrison in Sepilok to rehabilitate young orphaned Orangutans back to the forest. The population of Orangutans in our world today is only about 20,000. It is estimated that about 1,000 orangutans die yearly due to loss of habitat, hunting, sickness etc. Therefore the need of awareness and help to protect this endangered animal before extinction.



Day 07 April 09

After breakfast you will walk to the Rehabilitation Center. From there you will go for a walk in the forest to witness the feeding of orangutans and begin work on the project.

Day 08 April 10

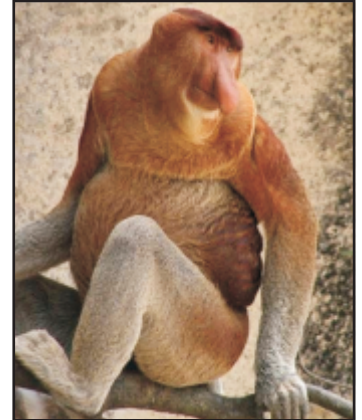
You will spend this day continuing the project work which will include making signs in English about the orangutans, rehabilitation etc., for placement around the park. In addition you will do some upgrade maintenance on their education centre, and the nearby rainforest education centre (just a few km away).

Day 09 April 11

This morning you will take a day trip to Lambuk to visit the Proboscis Monkey Lodge.

Day 10 April 12

You are then off for the 3 hour drive to Bilit Village. Time permitting there may be the opportunity to stop and see a palm oil plantation. Palm oil is the major export for Sabah's economy as it is used for cooking oil, margarine, shampoo, soap, lubricants and even diesel fuel. You will eventually arrive at Bilit Village where you will be staying at the Bilit Adventure Lodge. There will be a welcome dinner at Dewan Bilit with some local cultural dance and entertainment.

**Day 11 April 13**

After breakfast you will spend the day at the local school helping with English classes and other activities around the local school.

Day 12 April 14

Today you spend the morning at the school before enjoying an afternoon jungle cruise.

Day 13 April 15

The trip begins to wind down as you depart the village for the trip back to Sandakan. From there you will catch the short flight to Kota Kinabalu where you spend your last night in Borneo.

Day 12 April 16

Your trip home begins with a noon flight to Hong Kong, Vancouver and eventually to Calgary. With the crossing of the time zones you actually arrive home late in the afternoon, the same day you left.
