



Golf PANAMA

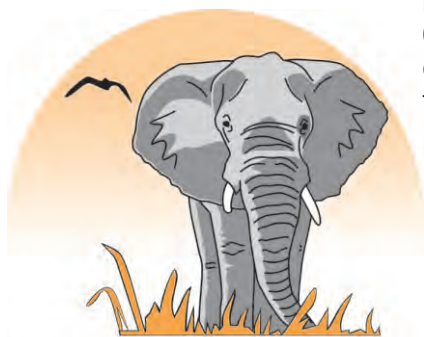
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Saturday, January 21

Depart Calgary early in the morning on Continental Airlines for Panama City. This flight will take you via Houston, where you have a quick connection before arriving at your destination early in the evening. On arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel, the Radisson Summit Golf Resort, located in the Canal area.

Sunday, January 22

Your first day of golf will be at the Summit Golf Resort. This world class championship golf facility is located in the east bank of the Panama Canal. The course is an 18 hole, 6,626 yard, par 72 championship course designed by noted American golf course architect Jeffrey Myers. The course is set on rolling hills overlooking the famous Gaillard Cut of the [Panama Canal](#) and the "Camino de Cruces" National Park.

Monday, January 23

Today brings you the next round of golf at the Tucan Country Club & Resort. A 180-acre private, gated golf community just 15 minutes from the capital, the course is located between a tropical rain forest and the Panama Canal Zone.

Tuesday, January 24

After breakfast you depart on a Canal and Rainforest Tour. You begin with a drive through the Panama Canal conservation area where you are surrounded by rainforest. Eventually you arrive at the town of Gamboa, where you board a small boat. You head out of the Chagres River, going into the Canal's main lake, Gatun Lake. While you are close to the shore you will see much of the local flora and fauna that inhabit the banks but as well you will find huge transiting ships passing close by! There will be time to visit several islands on the lake and then take a one hour hike in the jungle, where you will visit an abandoned US military base that is literally being eaten by the jungle.

After this you will visit the Canal Visitors Center to see the passing-through process and a presentation about the Canal and its expansion. The remainder of the day will be spent seeing the most important spots in Panama City.

Wednesday, January 25

Today you go back to the golf course for one more round at the Vista Mar Golf Resort.



Thursday, January 26

It is time to depart the city as you head for the Pacific Coast and the all inclusive Playa Blanca Resort. Here, in between golfing and taking in any of the other activities of the area, you will be able to relax on the beach during your spare time.

Friday, January 27

For your golf round today, you will be playing at the Coronado Golf Resort. Created by Tom and George Fazio and located in a beautiful setting, you will be playing on one of the best professional courses in Latin America. Afterward, it is back to the resort to relax on the beach or by the pool.

Saturday, January 28

Today you will be golfing at the Manta Raya Golf Club. Planned by internationally renowned designer Randall Thomson in association with the American Golf Course Design firm, Manta Raya Golf Club meets the demands of both the serious golfer and the weekend warrior. The luscious greens and natural surroundings create a fantastic setting for your golfing experience.

Sunday, January 29

Time to take a break from the beach and the golf, as you head off on a day trip to El Valle de Anton, known simply as El Valle. The town sits nestled in the second largest volcano crater in the world. A five by three mile crater created when a volcano blew its top off five million years ago. The result was a lovely steep valley surrounded by jagged mountain peaks and rich volcanic soil that gives way to flowers and verdant forest. Here you can enjoy the open air market, take in the therapeutic hot springs and mud baths or go zip-lining amongst the trees.



Monday, January 30

After a leisurely morning, it is time to pack up and head back into Panama City in the afternoon. The evening will be spent at your leisure as you get ready for the next adventure

Tuesday, January 31 til Thursday, February 02

After breakfast you depart the hotel in all-terrain vehicles and take the scenic ride through the mountains to the Caribbean coast and the island area of Kuna Yala. Once at the coast, you take your boats to the hotel. Once there you will be able to see the Kuna culture, their handcrafts and eat delicious seafood. Your time here will be spent visiting different paradise islands, relaxing on the gorgeous beaches or snorkeling amongst the incredible reefs. You can even see a sunken ship with a coral reef growing all over it. On the last day you will head back to Panama City.



Friday, February 03

Your last day is free to take in some last minute souvenir shopping in the malls and markets of Panama City or get in an optional last round of golf.

February 04 Saturday

The flight home departs mid morning and once again transits via Houston. The connection is made there and you continue back to Calgary where you arrive mid evening.
