



# Golf Vietnam

## February 10 - February 25, 2012 ITINERARY



### February 10 / 11

Depart Calgary late in the evening for the flight to Saigon via Vancouver and Hong Kong. With the crossing of the International Date Line, you will arrive into Saigon early on February 12th.

### February 12

You arrive in Saigon mid morning where you will be met and transferred to the Grand Hotel. That afternoon the group will go for a ½ day city tour that will include stops at the former Presidential Palace, War Relic Museum and Binh Tay Market.

### February 13

After breakfast drive to the extraordinary Cu Chi Tunnels, a labyrinth of narrow tunnels used to hide and attack from during the Vietnam War. From there you proceed to the Holy Say Temple at Tay Ninh, where an intriguing Cao Dai religious ceremony takes place. You get back to Saigon late that afternoon.

### February 14

After breakfast depart for a round of golf at the Vietnam Golf and Country Club. This 36 hole course was the first in Vietnam and is regarded as one of the premier courses in the country. Opened in 1994, it is located 20km from the centre of the city.

### **February 15**

Today you depart for another round of golf, this time at the Song Be Golf Resort, an enjoyable test for golfers of all levels. Designed over 100 hectares of land and surrounded by lush gardens and coconut plantations, the course features numerous lakes and undulating greens.

### **February 16**

This morning you depart Saigon for a drive to the Mekong Delta. Once there you will take a boat to Coconut Island where you can sample the food and view some local handicraft productions. The boat will continue on to Tan Thach where you get off and walk to Qui Son. You will float on a sampan through the narrow tree lined canals of the Mekong Delta before stopping for lunch on Qui Island. Later that afternoon you can enjoy the shops of Saigon.

### **February 17**

After an early breakfast you will check out of the hotel and transfer to the airport for the short flight to Danang. Once there you will be met and transferred to nearby Hoi An and your beach front resort, the Victoria Hoi An. After lunch you will be taken on a walking tour to explore this World Heritage site. Highlights will include ancient merchant houses dating back a couple hundred years, the 400 year old Japanese covered bridge and the vibrant river market.

### **February 18**

Back to the golf course. Today you will be playing at the Montgomerie Links, one of Vietnam's newest courses which is receiving rave reviews. Designed by Colin Montgomerie, this course is located close to the famed Marble Mountains and along the East China Sea.

### **February 19**

Today's golf round will be at the Danang Golf Club. This Greg Norman designed course is a true links layout also located along the sea and will evoke images of the famed English and Scottish sea side courses..

### **February 20**

A free day to relax on the beach or wander the streets of Hoi An.

### **February 21**

Today's round of golf will be back at the Danang Golf Club.

### **February 22**

This morning you say goodbye to the beach and head back to the Danang Airport for the flight to the capitol city of Vietnam, Hanoi. On arrival there you will be met and transferred to the historic Sofitel

### **February 23**

After breakfast you will be taken for a full day to explore Hanoi's illustrious history. You will start with a visit to the imposing marble edifice housing the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum before seeing his wooden house on stilts and the One Pillar Pagoda. You will then explore the first Vietnam university – the Temple of Literature founded over a thousand years ago. Then enjoy a one hour cyclo tour of Hanoi's Old Quarter.

### **February 24**

Your last round of golf in the country will be at the King Island Golf Club. This 36 hole course is regarded as the most beautiful in Northern Vietnam. Afterwards you return to your hotel to enjoy your last evening in Vietnam and get some last minute shopping in.

### **February 25**

You leave the hotel early in the morning with the transfer to the Hanoi airport. You will connect again in Hong Kong and Vancouver before arriving back in Calgary late in the afternoon of the same day.
