## Prague/Bratislava/Vienna/Budapest

### ITINERARY

**September 26 -October 09, 2027**

#### Sept 26 Day 1

Your trip begins as you arrive in Budapest. One of the most beautiful cities in the world, Budapest is the economic and cultural center of Hungary. The city is best known for big castles, ancient churches, appealing architectural bridges, and breathtaking avenues. You will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel with the remainder of the day free to relax or explore.

#### Sept 27 Day 2

Budapest is spread out over a large area and today you will enjoy a half day tour that will take you from the Buda hills, the banks of the Danube and Margaret Island to the bustling downtown Pest area. The first unique aspect that catches the eye of visitors is how the city is divided in two - Buda and Pest, connected by bridges - and that each side offers a distinct experience and glimpse into history. This evening there will be a welcome cocktail party to formally meet the rest of your group.

### Sept 28 Day 3

For your first round of golf on this trip you depart the hotel for the Botaniq Golf Club. This 18-hole course was designed by renowned golf course architect Hans G. Erhardt. Stretching along a valley, the fairways are in varied shapes to ensure true golfing pleasure. Eight water hazards spice up the game, while the positioning of flags on the undulating hills of the greens also add a challenge. The six different tees offer both beginner and advanced players the chance to accurately assess their golfing skills. After the round is complete, you will head back to the hotel for your last night in Budapest.



### Sept 29 Day 4

You check out of the hotel mid-morning as the group departs Budapest on the 2 hour drive to Bratislava. The capital of Slovakia is a food lover's paradise as it houses several traditional restaurants that offer delicious local dishes. After checking into the hotel, you will be taken for a 2 hour tour to see sites such as the Bratislava Castle and Blue church. The evening will be free to enjoy one of the many restaurants.

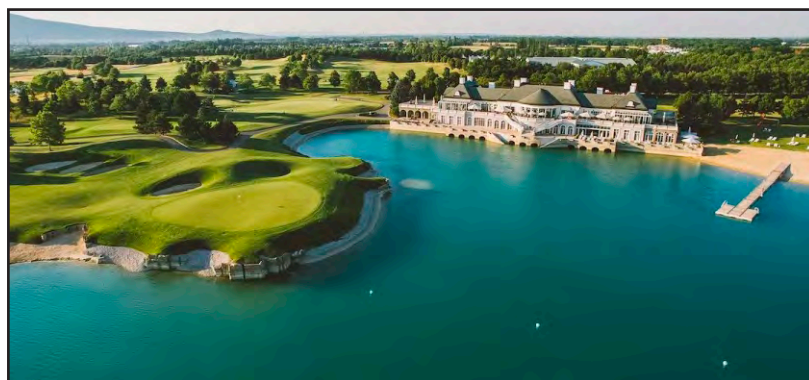
### Sept 30 Day 5

Time to head back to the golf course, this time at the Penati Golf Club. Home to 36 holes, you will be playing the Heritage course where world-renowned shaper Mick McShane was in charge of shaping the holes. His signature is on such courses as Kingsbarnes and The Castle Course in the Home of Golf, St Andrews Links in Scotland. After golf, it is back to the hotel to enjoy a free evening in Bratislava.



### Oct 01 Day 6

After breakfast, you once again check out of the hotel mid-morning and depart to your next destination, Vienna! The beautiful environment and attractive scenery have contributed to giving Vienna the title of 'The Goddess of Danube'. The magnificent Vienna Forest is located in the west of the Alpine foothills and the east overlooks the sparkling Danube River and the snowy Carpathian Mountains. Schonbrunn Palace which is the former summer residence of the Habsburgs is Vienna's most popular tourist attraction. Arriving at lunch time, the group will stop at the hotel before heading off on an afternoon tour that includes sightseeing, lunch and a wine tasting!



### Oct 02 Day 7

This morning you head back to the golf course as you depart to play the Fontana Country Club. Located to the south of Vienna, this 18-hole Doug Carrick and Hans Erhardt designed course opened for play in 1996 and consistently ranks in the top 10 courses in Europe. After golf you return to the city and a free evening in Vienna.

## Oct 03 Day 8

Today you have a free day to explore more of the city or possibly play an optional round of golf.

## Oct 04 Day 9

After breakfast, you depart for the Adamstal Golf Club located in the middle of the Lower Austrian foothills, one of the most spectacular golf courses in Europe, grand in design and always immaculately maintained. Designer Jeff Howes was able to cleverly Integrate streams and terrain levels, forest clearings and rock formations into the impressive landscape. After golf, you return to the city where you will be treated to a dinner at a traditional local restaurant for your last night in Vienna.



## Oct 05 Day 10

You check out of the hotel early this morning. Though the drive to Prague is not a long one, you will be taken first to the UNESCO heritage site of Cesky Krumlov. This stunningly beautiful town in southern Bohemia, and after Prague the country's second most visited tourist attraction. The historic center of the town was inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List in 1992. The architecture in the historic core of Český Krumlov has remained largely intact over the course of centuries. It is an excellent example of an old Central European town. On arrival, you will be treated to lunch and a 2 hour tour before you continue on to your final

## Oct 06 Day 11

Today you head back to the golf course for a round at the Albatross Golf Club. Located on the outskirts of the city, Designer Keith Preston came up with another wonderful 18-hole layout when the Albatross course opened in the summer of 2009. The course – presenting a mighty challenge at 6,858 metres when played from the championship tees – is laid out in two returning nines, each of which conclude with water-laden holes close to the clubhouse. After your round, you return to the hotel located in the heart of the city and your evening is free to enjoy a great dinner in one of the many nearby restaurants.



## Oct 07 Day 12

After breakfast you will be enjoy a city tour of Prague, known as “The City of a Hundred Spires”. This capital of the Czech Republic. is known to be the heart of its historic core because of all the magnificent baroque buildings, medieval Astronomical clocks, and Gothic Churches. The architecture of Prague is enough testament to its wealth and beauty. You will visit sites such as the Charles Bridge, Prague Castle, and St. Vitus Cathedral. Your tour will include lunch plus a beer tasting of the famous Czech beer!

### **Oct 08 Day 13**

It is time to head to your last round of golf, this time at the Oaks PGA Golf Course. This PGA National golf course was created by leading designer Kyle Phillips who has designed courses on every continent including three of the world's top 100 – Kingsbarns, Scotland, California Golf Club, USA, and South Cape, South Korea. The course is a trailblazer in environmentally sustainable golf design and is operated by Troon Privé, the private club division of Troon Golf. After golf, you return to the city for one last night in the incredible city of Prague and treated to a farewell dinner.



### **Oct 09 Day 14 Departure**

It is now time to head home as you check out of your hotel and transfer to the airport for your trip home or onward to your next destination.
