April 28 Day 1

The trip begins as you arrive at Paris's Charles De Gaulle Airport. On arrival you will be met and transferred to the Le Grand Pavillion Hotel, nestled in a peaceful forest just outside Paris near the charming town of Chantilly. Let the elegance of your surroundings embrace you as you unwind in this haven of French refinement before meeting the rest of the group at a welcome cocktail party.

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April 29 Day 2

After breakfast, you will have your first round of golf on the trip at the prestigious Chantilly Golf Club — one of France's most private and historic golf clubs. The Vineuil Course, designed by Tom Simpson in 1909, is a masterpiece of classic golf architecture. Renowned for its narrow fairways, deep bunkers, and fast, undulating greens, it demands precision and strategic shot-making. Having hosted multiple editions of the Open de France, it is widely considered one of the finest championship courses in Europe.



April 30 Day 3

This morning, you check out and transfer to Deauville in Normandy. You will arrive at noon to the Golf Barrière Deauville Club, overlooking the Normandy coast. After enjoying lunch at the club, you will tee off on a course which offers 27 elegant holes designed by Tom Simpson and Henry Cotton. With panoramic views over the sea and countryside, the course blends classic British design with French sophistication. Located just minutes from Deauville's glamorous seaside resort, it's a refined and scenic destination for golfers of all levels. After golf, you walk over to the hotel to check in and enjoy the remainder of the evening at your leisure.

May 01 Day 4

Today, you take a break from golf and experience the beauty of Normandy and also our Canadian military history. It begins as you transfer to the Mont Saint Michel Abbaye and from there a visit to the Canadian War Cemetery in Caen. From there you continue to Mont-Saint-Michel where you will have a guided tour. Rising majestically from the tides, the Mont-Saint-Michel is a marvel of medieval architecture and spiritual heritage. Surrounded by the ever-changing waters of the bay, this iconic

abbey offers a timeless journey through cobbled streets, ancient stone walls, and panoramic views that capture the soul of Normandy. A place where history, legend, and natural beauty come together in perfect harmony. Afterwards you return back to your hotel.

May 02 Day 5

After breakfast it is back to the golf course. Perched atop the majestic cliffs overlooking the English Channel,

the Golf d'Étretat offers one of the most breathtaking settings in Europe. Between sea and sky, each hole reveals dramatic views of the iconic white cliffs and rolling waves below. This historic course, known for its technical challenges and coastal beauty, invites golfers to experience the perfect blend of sport serenity, and natural grandeur. A true jewel of Normandy for lovers of the game — and of the exceptional.



May 03 Day 6

Today you step into history with a moving day in Normandy, where the past echoes across windswept beaches and solemn memorials. Your journey begins along the iconic D-Day landing sites, where bravery and sacrifice forever marked the sands of Omaha Beach. Accompanied by your guide, you'll explore poignant landmarks such as the Colleville-sur-Mer, Overlord Museum and the American Cemetery, where rows of white crosses stand in silent tribute. This powerful and emotional experience offers a deep connection to the legacy of World War II — a day of remembrance, reflection, and honour.

May 04 Day 7

It is time to depart Normandy and head to the Loire Valley, where nature and nobility meet at the awe-inspiring Château de Chambord. Surrounded by pristine woodlands and serene waterways, this architectural marvel invites you to discover its legendary double-helix staircase, grand salons, and sweeping rooftop views. Said to bear the genius of Leonardo da Vinci, Chambord is more than a castle — it's a poetic expression of French Renaissance artistry. A journey through elegance, history, and timeless wonder. After enjoying lunch and tour of Château de Chambord, you will continue on to the Hôtel de La Borde is a refined 4-star retreat that blends countryside charm with discreet elegance. Set within a beautifully restored



estate surrounded by lush woodlands, this boutique hotel offers a peaceful escape just a short drive from the majestic castles of the Loire Valley.



May 05 Day 8

Once more, time to get back to the golf course. Located in the heart of the Sologne region, Les Aisses Golf Club offers an 18-hole championship course designed by Martin Hawtree. The course spans 6,648 meters (par 72) and is renowned for its heathland layout, featuring wide fairways, strategic bunkering, and natural water hazards. Set within a 280-hectare estate, the course provides a tranquil and challenging golfing experience amidst forests, moors, and ponds.

May 06 Day 9

Your next round of golf will be at the Château de Cheverny Golf Club. Set amidst the historic hunting grounds of the Château de Cheverny, this 18-hole par-71 course, designed by Olivier Van Der Vynckt, stretches over 5,946 meters. The course harmoniously integrates into the natural landscapes of the Sologne region, featuring flat terrain with water hazards and moderate technical difficulty. Golfers can enjoy a serene environment where deer and other wildlife are often spotted at dawn and dusk. The course's proximity to the renowned Château de Cheverny adds a touch of historical charm to the golfing experience.



May 07 Day 10

The tour of Normandy and Loire Valley is now done so now it is time to return to Paris. On arrival, you will get checked into the Hôtel Échiquier, nestled in the vibrant 10e arrondissement, just minutes from the Grands Boulevards, Opéra Garnier. This 4-star boutique hotel blends historical charm and modern comfort, inspired by the art nouveau style of early 20th-century Paris.



May 08 Day 11

It is now time to go home or on to your next adventure. You check out of your hotel in the morning and transfer to the airport in time to catch your flights home.
